CA ARPAS/LOS ANGELES GRAIN EXCHANCE SCHOLARSHIP

Nominations for the CA ARPAS/LAGE scholarships are now being accepted. The purpose of these scholarships is to recognize outstanding upper division California <u>undergraduate</u> students who are majoring in animal agriculture. Selection will be based on academic performance, background and financial need. There will be two scholarships of \$1,000 each. The deadline for applications will be September 15th. The award will be presented at the annual Continuing Education Conference of the California Chapter in October at Harris Ranch in Coalinga, California.

Candidates for the scholarships must be upper division (junior or senior as determined by their college) and <u>be nominated in writing by their faculty advisor.</u>

Applicants should provide:

- 1. A brief biography (one page)
- 2. List of activities
- 3. Statement of educational purpose.
- 4. Transcripts of all college courses to date.

The CA ARPAS/LAGE scholarship was established by the Los Angeles Grain Exchange and was transferred to CA ARPAS in 2006 upon the dissolution of the LAGE. The scholarships are funded by funds generated from the seed money provided by the LAGE.

The CA ARPAS executive committee sets the standards for scholarships and shall select the recipients.
